- Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) sees walk-ins to complete applications for government income assistance programs:
  - Temporary Cash Assistance
  - Food Stamps
  - Medical Assistance
  - Child care subsidy program
  - Home energy programs

### FOOD, CLOTHING, & DIAPERS

Emergency Choice Food Pantry

- Monday, Wednesday, & Friday from 9am-4pm
- Intake with caseworker required. Bring proof of MC residency, financial need, and proof of people in household. Bring your own bags.
- Limited to emergencies only.

Capital Area Food Bank Mobile Market

- Second Monday of every month from 3-6pm (no food in Oct, Jan, Feb)
- Free Produce: Bring your own bag/box; one share of food per family

MANNA Food Center Referrals

- Montgomery County residents only
- Agency or self-referral required
- Receive groceries once a month

Clothing Shop

- Clothes, shoes, household items
- Infant to adult sizes (\$.25 to \$2 per item)
- First Monday of every month from 8am-3pm (2nd Monday during holidays)
