

# Pentecost

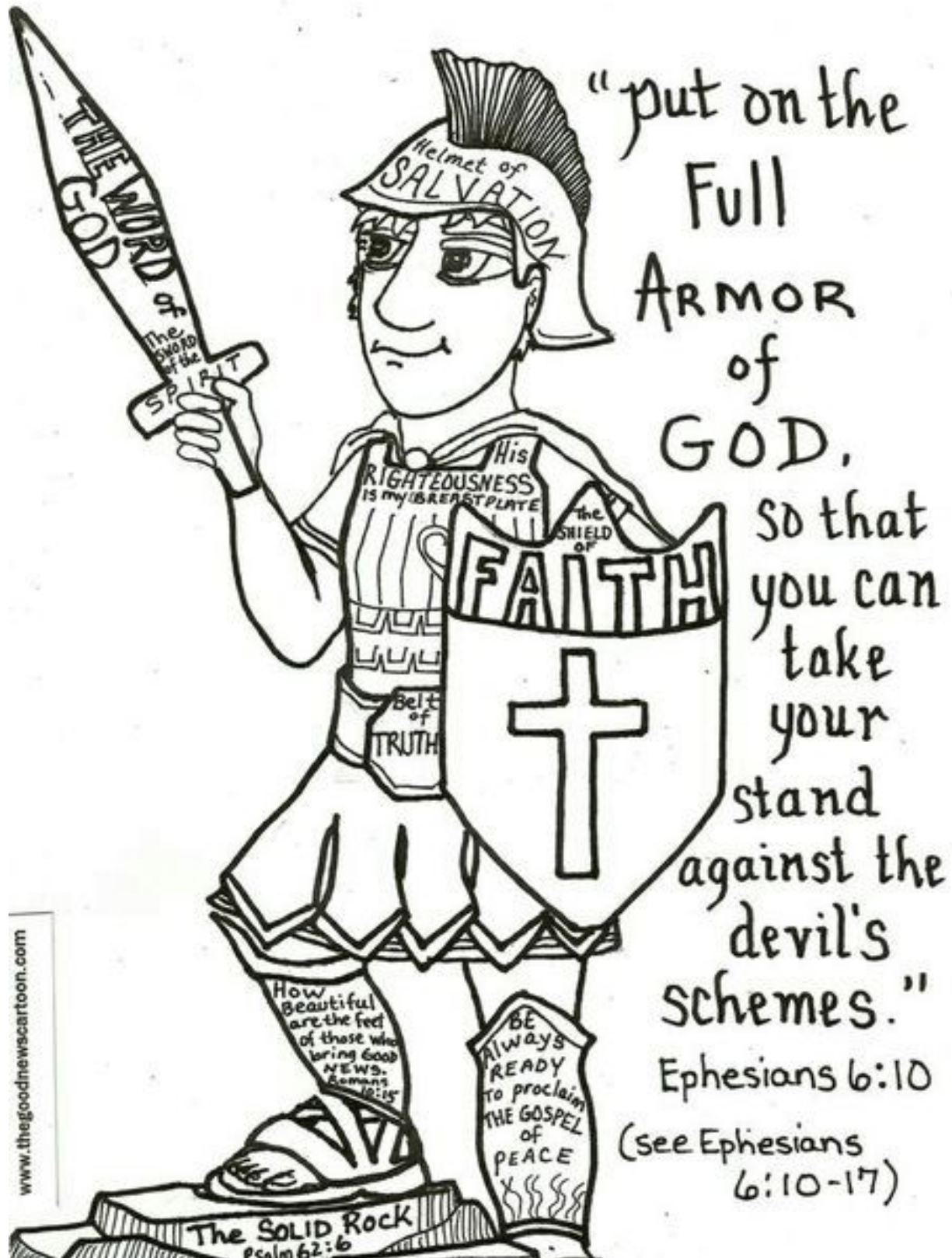
Pentecost is when we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter (the name comes from the Greek pentekoste, "fiftieth") . When Jesus Ascended into Heaven, He promised us that He would send His Advocate, the Holy Spirit, so that we can proclaim the Good News of the Lord.



## The Coming of the Spirit.

1 When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. 2 And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind,<sup>1</sup> and it filled the entire house in which they were. 3 Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire,<sup>2</sup> which parted and came to rest on each one of them. 4 And they were all filled with the holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues,<sup>3</sup> as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.<sup>4</sup> -*Acts 2: 1-4*

In receiving the Holy Spirit, the Apostle, were enabled to boldly proclaim the Lord's message. We can daily ask the Holy Spirit to give us strength and courage to proclaim God's message, so that we can be "soldiers for Christ"

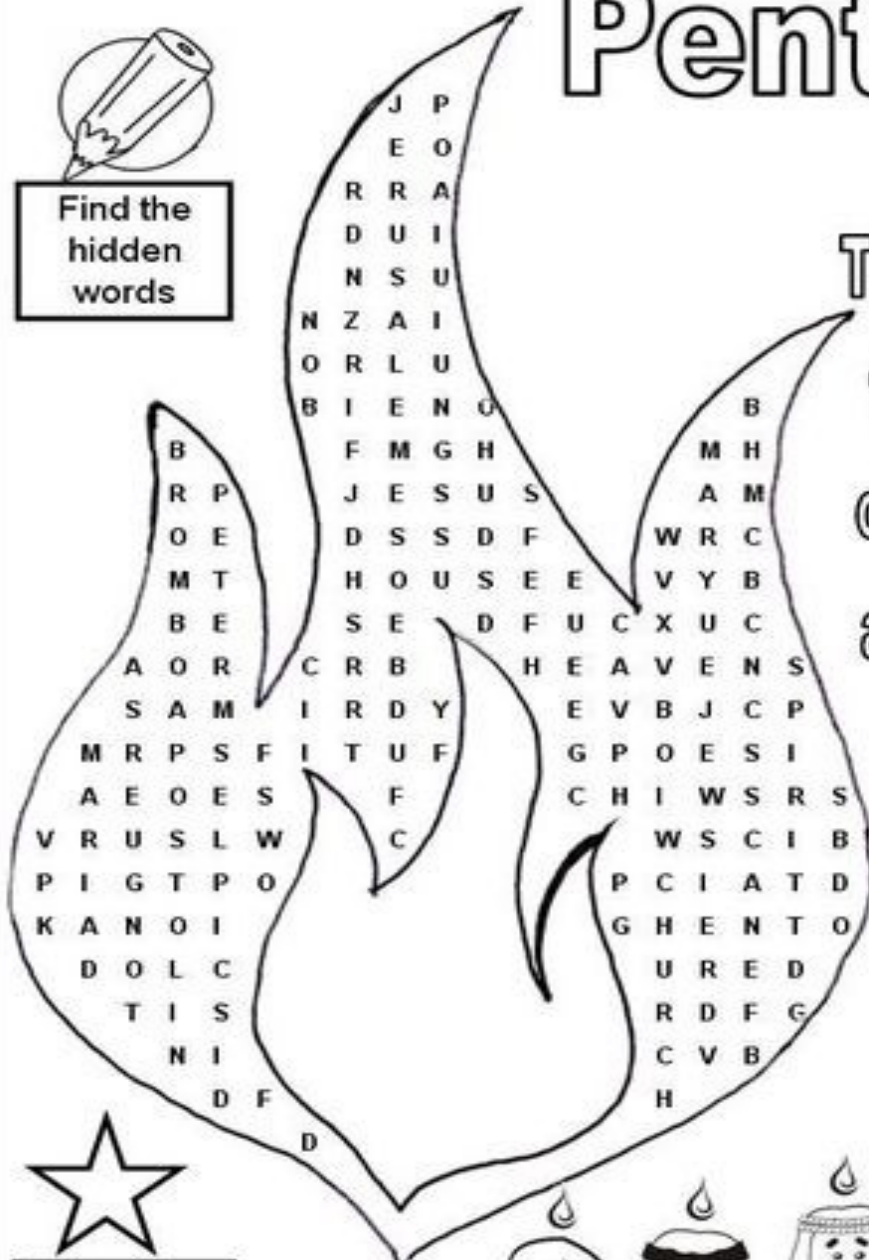

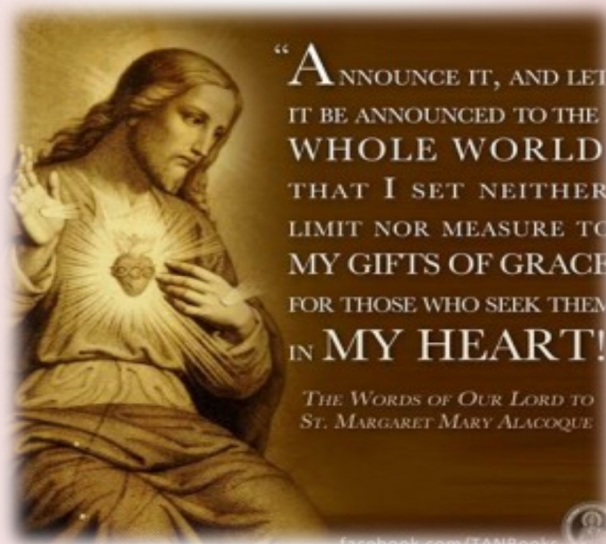


# In June, we remember the feast of Corpus Christit
