Parish Financial Assistance

The Archdiocese is ready to provide financial support to our parishes to enable them to continue to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ and minister to the people in our community. This financial support includes potential suspension of various assessments and fees as well as potential loans to parishes that would be repaid when public Masses resume. Included you will see the priorities and criteria that will be used to assess the relative financial needs of the parishes and to prioritize the granting of financial support and also find the document to be submitted by those parishes requesting financial assistance. Many marriage license offices are closed. It is possible to perform a sacramental marriage without a marriage license. We will provide details on the process in my e-mail to you on Monday.

Government Relief Efforts

Both the archdiocesan Office of General Counsel and the Office of Human Resources are finalizing their review of the recently announced governmental relief efforts. Next week we will provide more detailed guidance on resources that will be available to the archdiocese, our employees, parishes, and affiliated ministries. Some of the procedures to apply for these benefits/programs are still being developed at the governmental level, and we will continue to analyze and provide further updates promptly.

We checked on how this works and wanted to give you more information about the offer. To get the free offer you must enter credit card information. Please note that the site has a disclaimer that states you will not be charged until after 40 days. If you scroll down below on the credit card information screen you will find the disclaimer. We recommend you set a reminder <u>before</u> the 40th day to cancel your subscription if you do not wish to start a paid subscription.

Use of MDLIVE – access to health care remotely

As previously communicated, <u>https://www.mdlive.com/</u> gives you secure access to health care from the convenience of your phone, computer or tablet. MD Live also provides behavioral health assistance through online counseling sessions. This is available to the clergy and employees who have health insurance through the Archdiocese of Washington. You can go to the website and register for MD Live now. That way your account will be ready to go if you need to contact a doctor. This is an excellent resource if you have a nonemergency medical need and are concerned about going to your doctor's office.
