## Possible Grants to Assist Food Pantries

## **Copyright Issues**

The Archdiocese is in the final stage of securing group copyright licensing from One License for parishes seeking to include hymns in their online Masses or services. The license would offer significant discounts and allow participating parishes to use hymns and written lyrics in prerecorded or live streamed videos distributed online, including via podcasts, websites, YouTube, Facebook, Zoom, Vimeo, and Instagram.

If your parish would like to be included in the group copyright licensing to use hymns online—or if it has an existing podcast/streaming license with One License—please contact the Office of General Counsel at **legaladmin@adw.org** no later than Wednesday, May 20, 2020. Parishes without podcast/streaming licenses may not use copyrighted hymns in their online Masses or services.
