Archbishop Gregory Participating in June 30 Online Dialogue on 'Race in America'

Archbishop Gregory will discuss the role faith can play in overcoming racial injustice during a June 30 online discussion with the American Jewish Committee (AJC). The talk will be online via Zoom at 11 a.m.

Titled "Race in America: The Faith Perspective," the dialogue will feature Archbishop Gregory and Rabbi Noam Marans, the director of interreligious and intergroup relations for the AJC. They will discuss how religion can be a source for good as America confronts the current health and race crises and what faith and political confluences must be overcome in addressing racial injustice.

ADW.ORG Email Accounts

As you know from previous communications and alerts, it is the policy of the Archdiocese of Washington that ADW.ORG email addresses be exclusively used for all parish, school or work-related email communications. This mandate is imperative for critical oversight, administrative, and legal reasons.

As a first step toward further implementation of the directive, effective July 1, 2020, requests to forward ADW.ORG email accounts will no longer be processed. Specifically, no **new** forwarding from ADW.ORG email accounts to personal or parish email accounts will be accommodated, nor will the IT team modify for forwarding any existing ADW.ORG account.

Also, please note that for security reasons, any ADW.ORG email account that has not been logged into for 45 days or more will be disabled and will require priests and staff to contact the IT Department at IT@adw.org. For assistance with ADW.ORG email accounts, please contact the IT Helpdesk at IT@adw.org.
