Archbishop Gregory Letter to Priests

Linked <u>here</u> is a letter from Archbishop Gregory to priests in which he announces that effective tomorrow, June 9, parishes in the District of Columbia, Prince George's County and Montgomery County may begin to celebrate public Masses for up to ten persons including clergy. A pastor may delay if still needing time to prepare or wanting to wait until his jurisdiction allows greater numbers.
