#### Archbishop Gregory to Celebrate Mass of Peace and Justice on Friday, August 28

Tomorrow, Friday Aug. 28 at 4 p.m., Archbishop Wilton Gregory will celebrate a Mass of Peace and Justice in honor of the 57th anniversary of the 1963 March on Washington.

The Faithful are invited to watch the live streamed Mass from St. Matthew's Cathedral, linked **here**.

Auxiliary Bishops Mario Dorsonville, Roy E. Campbell, and Michael Fisher will concelebrate the Mass, which is being organized by the Archdiocese of Washington's Office of Cultural Diversity and Outreach and the Secretariat of Pastoral Ministry and Social Concerns (PMSC).

At the 1963 March on Washington, Archbishop Patrick O'Boyle -- who began integrating parishes and schools in the Archdiocese of Washington shortly after becoming the archbishop of Washington in 1948 -- offered the invocation before Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. gave his famous "I Have a Dream" speech. Cardinal O'Boyle retired in 1973 and died in 1987.

## **Parish Food Pantry Grants**

In late July, the Archdiocesan Office of Social Concerns announced the opportunity for all parish based food pantries to apply for grant funding through the newly formed *Parish Pantry Support Program*. The program was created to meet the increased demand and necessity of parish food pantries to respond to the COVID 19 pandemic.

After four weeks, the Parish Pantry Support Program has worked with 29 parishes and their food pantry program. A total of \$92,700 has been awarded for an average distribution of \$3,196. This program has already benefitted the charitable works of the archdiocese.

Due to the continued needs, the Office of Social Concerns is moving forward to consider second-round applications and disbursement of funds to parishes.
