As part of the new ADW anti-racism initiative, 'Made in God's Image: Pray and Work to End the Sin of Racism (CCC 1935)', an archdiocesan wide prayer has been written by Archbishop Gregory, Bishop Dorsonville, Bishop Campbell and Bishop Fisher. We offer you this Family Prayer for Justice and Human Dignity to share with your parishioners via electronic means, as well as consider praying the prayer at the conclusion of Masses. One Congregation One Precinct (OneCOP) Initiative

As a follow up to my announcing this initiative last week, The "One Congregation One Precinct" (OneCOP) initiative is a program developed to improve community safety by creating strategic partnerships between beat and patrol officers and faith congregations. The initiative aims to allow officers who participate in these programs to personally know people in their assigned communities by building relationships with congregations in their area of responsibility.
