Come Home to the Heart of Communion Resource

The Office of Catechesis has developed a resource titled "Come Home to the Heart of Communion," that may assist you in your efforts to invite the faithful of your parish back to the Eucharistic celebration. New Montgomery County Executive Order on Mass Attendance

Montgomery County has issued a <u>new executive order</u>, effective at 5 p.m. on September 22, which allows for greater attendance in religious facilities to about four persons per 200 sq. ft. (specifically, the order requires dividing total square footage of worship space by 50) up to a maximum of **40 percent building capacity**. Previously, the County restricted gatherings in religious facilities to one person/family per 200 sq. ft., which equates to about 25-30 percent of building capacity.

Also, leaders at Mass must be screened, including having their temperatures checked before serving as well as asking if they have any symptoms or have had any contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID. This screening should include all priests and deacons (already mandated in our Archdiocesan re-opening guidelines) as well as those who are in closer proximity to parishioners, including Eucharistic Ministers and Ushers. There is **no** requirement to similarly screen those who attend Mass.

Open House at Saint John XXIII Priest Retirement Residence
