## **Chrism Mass**

Archbishop Wilton Gregory will celebrate the 2020 Chrism Mass at 4 p.m. on September 14 at the Cathedral of Saint Matthew the Apostle.

While the Archbishop had hoped to celebrate this Mass with all the priests, because of the current limit on the number of persons that can attend Mass in the District, attendance at the 2020 Chrism Mass has been limited by invitation only to the College of Consultors, Deans, members of the Clergy Personnel Board and Priest Council, newly ordained, jubilarians, and representatives from the various religious communities in the Archdiocese. If you have received an invitation, please respond by Thursday.

Each Dean will coordinate the Holy Oils distribution for each parish in his deanery as the distribution will **not** take place directly after the conclusion of the Chrism Mass but within the days following.

The Chrism Mass will be live streamed and can be viewed here.
