Social Media Policies

Recently, Paula Gwynn Grant, Secretary of Communications, presented to Priest Council, the new *Polices for the Pastoral Use of Social Media and Electronic Communications*, which are linked **here** for printing on back to back pages and linked **here** for printing on one sided pages.

As seen in the document, Archbishop Gregory has approved and promulgated these new policies and they are effective immediately. These updated Social Media Policies are for all of our priests, deacons, employees, and volunteers who use personal social media or who work with parish/ministry/school social media. The Policies include best practices and guidance for your personal and parish/ministry/school social media content, specific requirements, and information to securely and effectively manage your social media accounts.

Please distribute these updated policies to your appropriate staff and volunteers and have them sign the included acknowledgment forms. Please keep a log when you collect the signed forms. All employee signed forms should be kept in the employee personnel file.
