

Dear Brother Priest,

I write today to provide you with updates. I will continue to keep you informed as we navigate this challenging time.

## <u>FEMA Reimbursement Form and Process for Archdiocese of Washington</u> <u>Parishes/Schools</u>

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has approved the archdiocese's application on behalf of ADW parishes and schools to request reimbursement for up to 75% of parish and school's sanitization expenses that were incurred as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic from January 20, 2020 to September 14, 2020. As the next step for FEMA to reimburse for the eligible sanitization costs, ADW must submit documentation of such expenses on behalf of each parish and school.

## **Eligible expenses** for reimbursement include:

- Third party vendor/contractor COVID-19 facility cleaning fees
- Building cleaning fees may include one-time COVI19 sanitization by vendor, and/or recurring sanitization by vendor that is in addition to normal (non-COVID-19) cleaning
- Cleaning and disinfection supplies and equipment purchased to address COVID-19
- Please also include any specialized equipment purchased for COVID-19 disinfection purposes, including air purifiers, dehumidifiers, electrostatic sprayers, UV lights and barriers/plastic dividers.\*
- Personal protective equipment: Masks, gloves, face shields \*

\*Please note that FEMA has not clarified whether specialized cleaning equipment and PPE are reimbursable expenses, and FEMA may not reimburse for these categories.

Employee wages, donations, volunteer time, and general operating costs or other COVID-19-related expenses are **NOT** eligible expenses for reimbursement. Expenses without supporting documentation are also not eligible for reimbursement.

This FEMA reimbursement program should not be confused with any other grant or funding source related to COVID-19 expenses. You should continue to pursue other sources of supplementary funding. If you have received any federal or state funding for the above expense categories, you may not apply for duplicate funding from FEMA.

Because all of the parish/school submissions need to be organized into one form after we receive them, handwritten forms are not acceptable. Please return the completed form by December 3, 2020 by emailing the form to fema@adw.org.
