Annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

For over 100 years, Christians worldwide have come together during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, which annually takes place during January 18-25, ending on the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. The Pontifical Council for the Promotion of Christian Unity actively works with its ecumenical partners worldwide to encourage Christians to pray and perform acts of solidarity together during this week as a way to foster the unity of all Christians.

For Christian leaders, that through honest and fruitful dialogue, we may help to bring about unity and mutual love among all Christians, let us pray to the Lord.
