HVAC Replacement at the Pastoral Center Reminder

A reminder that the Pastoral Center has begun the heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system replacement. All of our offices have vacated the Pastoral Center building and are in the process of transitioning to our temporary Pastoral Center locations where we will be operating into the 1st quarter of 2022.

Cardinal Gregory's office is now fully operational at the Saint John Paul II Seminary.

The Department of Pastoral Ministry and Social Concerns is fully operational at the Pope Francis Center on the campus of Saint Mary Parish, Landover Hills.

The Office of the Moderator of the Curia, Ministerial Leadership, Catholic Schools, Human Resources, and Legal will be fully operational at the Quinn Dormitory at the Catholic University of America, and other departments will be operating in a hybrid of in-person and remote. Our current goal is to have the operations at Quinn up and running by Monday, July 26th.

As a reminder, all of our office phone numbers, e-mail and computer systems of the Pastoral Center are fully functional, with the exception of a few days when the HVAC project is working in particular areas of the Pastoral Center that require a full system outage. This includes the phone system to be not functioning fully from July 16 – July 26. When calls are placed to staff during these few days, an operator will answer all calls and deliver messages as needed. It is also suggested that for these few days, you use email to communicate with staff.

USPS mail can continue to be sent to the Pastoral Center's post office box address of P.O. Box 29260, Washington, DC 20017-0260. Items to be delivered by a courier, or FedEx, can be delivered to the rear door of the Pastoral Center. Items to be dropped off in person, beginning August 6, can be dropped off at the Quinn Dormitory on the campus of CUA.
