Baptism Preparation Program – Springs of Faith

The Office for Catechesis is launching a pilot of the Baptism preparation program *Springs of Faith* by Loyola Press for 20 parishes. Parishes participating in the program will receive the parish starter kit at no cost to the parish (a \$275 value).

Pilot parishes must attend the initial evening training session either August 4th (English) or August 11th (Spanish). These meetings will be held virtually. Login information will be provided when you register.
