## Revised Forming Disciples Religion Curriculum Guide

Linked **here** in English and **here** in Spanish, you will find a revised *Forming Disciples Religion Curriculum Guide* for use in Parishes and Catholic Schools. This revision reflects a consultative response to the evolving catechetical needs and is designed to help both parents and catechists fulfill the mission of leading others to faith in Jesus Christ. The revised curriculum guide includes key prayers, Scripture stories and saints at each grade level. This guide is being sent to the priests now and will be sent to the catechetical leaders and principals on Friday, February 11.

Rooted in kerygma, and built on the five tasks of catechesis, the framework focuses on twenty-six essential truths of the faith. These truths (also referred to as standards/themes) will be presented at each grade level. With this focus, the total number of indicators will be 20 - 45 per grade level, rather than the current 64-123 per grade.

The curriculum revision necessitated reconsideration of the Faith Knowledge Assessment. Catholic school students will continue to take the assessment as part of their subject area testing. Parish Religious Education programs will use Kahoot! – an online gaming app – for the assessment. The Office for Catechesis has paid for the Kahoot! license fee for each parish and will provide training in use of this tool for the annual assessment.
