Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

On Friday, March 25,2022, the Solemnity of the Annunciation, His Eminence, Cardinal Wilton Gregory, will celebrate a special Mass at 12:00 Noon in the Great Upper Church of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in response to the request of our Holy Father, Pope Francis, for the bishops of the world to join him in an Act of Consecration of Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

The Mass will be open to the public and livestreamed on the Basilica's website linked <u>here</u>.

Priests of the archdiocese are welcome to concelebrate this Mass. Registration is requested by the Basilica using the link <u>here</u> and clicking "Register Now"

Parishes are encouraged to pray the Prayer of Consecration, linked <u>here</u> in English and <u>here</u> in Spanish, during the celebration of Mass this Friday.

Please distribute this information to your communities in the way you determine is best. The faithful and all people of goodwill are invited to join for this special Mass and Consecration as we pray for peace in Ukraine and around the world.

Energy Benchmarking for DC Parishes Due April 1, 2022

District of Columbia pastors are reminded that <u>new for this year</u>, building owners between <u>25,000 and 50,000 square feet</u> are required by law to report their past energy usage to the District of Columbia Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) by <u>Friday, April 1, 2022</u>. This requirement includes our churches and schools. If your building is required to benchmark, you should have received a letter from the ADW Facilities and Real Estate Management Office notifying you to comply with the energy benchmarking requirements and containing links and guidance for completing the benchmarking. Dear Building Owner/Manager/Reporter,

The District's annual energy benchmarking deadline of April 1 is just two weeks away. Make sure you have entered complete and accurate energy and water use for calendar year 2021 and updated all property use details in Portfolio Manager. If you are unsure if your building is covered by the benchmarking law, please reference the 2022 Covered Building List <u>here</u>.

<u>Reporting Data to DOEE</u>

As a reminder, all benchmarking reports are submitted using Automatic Annual Reporting through Portfolio Manager Web Services. If your property is already enrolled in automatic reporting you will not have to manually submit benchmarking data to DOEE, as your report will be automatically downloaded on the reporting deadline. You can confirm that you are enrolled by going to the "Summary" tab of your property, scrolling down to the box that says "Sharing this Property" where see "District of should Columbia Annual vou Reporting (District of Columbia Annual Reporting)" listed "Exchange with Data" permissions. If you are not yet enrolled, please refer to our step-by-step guide, or watch our recorded Automatic Reporting webinar.
