## Mass in Commemoration of Juneteenth

As we prepare for a holiday weekend observance of <u>Juneteenth</u>, we invite the Faithful to join us in prayer at the first archdiocesan Mass to commemorate the oldest nationally known celebration that marks the end of slavery in the United States.

The Mass will be at St. Joseph Catholic Church (2020 St. Joseph's Dr., Upper Marlboro, MD 20774) on Sunday, June 19, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. The Most Rev. Roy E. Campbell, Jr., Auxiliary Bishop of Washington, will be the principal celebrant and homilist.

## **Grant For Maryland Parishes**

The Maryland Catholic Conference has notified the Pastoral Center of the availability of grants under the <u>Protecting Against Hate Crimes (PAHC) program</u> to fund, among other things, security needs at churches in the face of increasing threats of anti-religious property damage. <u>Allowable grant uses</u> include security-related facility upgrades such as security cameras, improved lighting



and door-hardening, as well as training for existing staff and employing security personnel.

Unfortunately, we learned of this opportunity very recently and the grant process is very time sensitive. While the deadline to apply for a grant is June 24, the deadline to obtain access to the online <u>Grant Management System (GMS)</u> application portal is June 10. Thus, if you <u>might</u> be interested in applying for grants for your parish or school, **please email <u>legaladmin@adw.org</u> by noon this Friday, June 10**, to request the initial required <u>documents</u> to timely obtain access to the GMS portal, even if you decide later not to actually apply.
