02.02.02	Virgin Mary	Mary, who by the power of the Holy Spirit, became the mother of Jesus.
02.02.01	Gospels	The four books in the Bible that tell us about Jesus.
02.02.02	Parables	Stories told by Jesus to help us understand God's love for us and how we should live.
02.02.04	Miracle	Something that can only happen, or be explained, by the power of God.
02.03.01	Sacrament	A visible sign where we encounter Jesus as he works invisibly in our souls to give us his grace.
02.03.02	Eucharist	The Body and Blood of Jesus really present in the consecrated bread and wine even though we cannot see a change.
