Catechetical Day – Saturday, October 29

Catechetical Day 2022 is Saturday, October 29 at Don Bosco Cristo Rey High School. This year's theme – (Re)Discover the Beauty of the Eucharist – is critical for our Church today. Cardinal Gregory will offer the keynote address and celebrate Mass in the morning. There will be over 40 afternoon breakout sessions (in English and Spanish) for catechists to dive deeper into the theme.

This event should be a priority for your parish catechetical leader and is an excellent day of formation for your catechists whether they be catechists of children and youth, RCIA teams, or adult faith formation.
