My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we embark on a new and hopeful year, first and foremost, I am filled with gratitude for your past support of the Church of Washington through the Annual Appeal.

In 2022, we ordained ten new priests, supported twelve local crisis pregnancy centers, welcomed more than 800 new Catholics into the Church, educated more than 25,000 youth in our schools, and ministered to countless more families and individuals throughout our archdiocese. Thank you for your generous giving. Thank you also for your prayers. Please be assured of my own prayers for you.





Vocations, Seminarian Education and Clergy and Religious Support \$4,200,000

By donating to the Annual Appeal, you support our current and future generations of archdiocesan priests, deacons and religious. Seminarian education is the greatest beneficiary of the Annual Appeal, with funds also providing for essential living expenses at the St. John Paul II Seminary in Washington, D.C. For ordained priests and ministers, ongoing formation and other means of support are provided by the Annual Appeal.

Catholic Education and Catechesis \$2,000,000

Forming youth in the faith through our Catholic schools, parish religious education programs and many youth activities is an essential ministry of the archdiocese supported by your Annual Appeal gift. Overall, more than 40,000 local youth are impacted by your support. The Annual Appeal also supports RCIA and RCIC programs, accompanying new Catholics in their journey toward full communion in the Church.

Chaplains for Campus Ministries, Hospitals and Prisons \$1,500,000

Across six local campus ministries, ADW chaplains ignite the spiritual life of hundreds of college students, Catholic and non-Catholic alike, through formational and service activities. At the same time, ADW chaplains also minister to the sick and dying in hospitals, as well as to those incarcerated in local detention centers. Thanks to our chaplains, the sacramental life of our archdiocese extends well beyond our parishes.





Social Justice and Outreach Ministries \$1,800,000

The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Washington Secretariat for Pastoral Ministry and Social Concerns extends the outreach of our parishes through Deaf and disabilities ministries, evangelization programs, ethnic apostolates and more. The Annual Appeal also supports Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Washington, which operates nearly 60 programs opening doors of help and hope.

Communications and Outreach \$700,000

Social media and other forms of digital outreach increasingly form the "mission fields" of the modern Church. By supporting the Annual Appeal, you enable our archdiocese to utilize these tools of evangelization and communication more effectively and expansively. You also empower our writers and editors, reporters, photographers and videographers from across the archdiocese to share the good news and works of our local Church.
