October Mass Headcount – Repeated

Thank you for the care you have taken to assure the success of the October Headcount in previous years.

Since the statistics collected from the October Headcount will help us to assess whether a parish is growing or diminishing in numbers, please make every effort to see that the headcount is carried out as accurately as possible. This information is useful not only for parish planning, but also for tracking growth and decline in the different geographical areas of the archdiocese.

Additionally, it is a valuable tool for projecting the total population of the archdiocese, for providing information for statistical reports, and for distribution of materials for various initiatives.
