The Youth Mass of Celebration and Thanksgiving - January 20, 2023

The Catholic Youth Organization is excited to welcome pastors, parochial vicars, and deacons, to join His Eminence Wilton Cardinal Gregory and young people of The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Washington to worship together in a celebration of life.

The Youth Mass of Celebration and Thanksgiving is a special event being held at Saint Matthew's Cathedral and will include music, witness talks, a keynote speaker and most importantly, Mass. As you are aware, seating at Saint Matthews is limited. ADW parish, school youth and college campus ministries have priority access to the Mass. Information regarding the Mass and the registration process was previously sent to parish youth ministers, schools, and youth contacts. Once notified, parishes and schools quickly began to register. We currently have just over 100 seats available for reservation. A waiting list will be created and parishes/schools/campuses will be notified as seats become available. However, there is limited open seating at the Cathedral that will be on a first-come, first-served basis the day of the Mass.

Records Retention Policy Training Sessions for Parishes and Schools

The Office of Archives is holding short online training sessions for Parish and School staff. *The training is for all new staff and for those who have attended but feel that they need a refresher.* Each training session will last a little over an hour and provide a forum for staff to ask questions. Copies of the Record Retention Policy, dispositions forms, and a Parish and Schools Record Manual is housed in the training platform and can be downloaded.

The parish staff that should attend include: pastors and parochial vicars, bookkeepers, parish secretaries, directors of religious education, and child protection coordinators and any parish staff member responsible for keeping records.

School staff include principals, secretaries, child protection coordinators, and school administrators. Teaching staff do not need to attend unless they have other administrative duties outside the classroom that involve handling records.
