Earthquakes in Turkey and Syria Support

Catastrophic earthquakes in Turkey and Syria have resulted in major devastation in areas already impacted by years of war. The people of that region are now in dire need of medical care, shelter, food, water, clothing, and other supplies, as well as the materials to rebuild homes, schools, businesses and infrastructure.

In the wake of this humanitarian tragedy, we join our prayers with Pope Francis, Cardinal Gregory and people around the world for those who have died and for survivors who are homeless, injured and/or suffering, and everyone who is affected. We also ask for the Lord's gifts of strength and perseverance upon all who are engaged in the massive work of relief and recovery.
