## Message from Dr. Jeannine Marino Regarding 2022 October Mass Count Report

As you are aware, parishes are asked each October to conduct headcounts of persons attending Sunday Masses (including Saturday Vigil), and this data is then compiled for the annual October Mass Attendance Headcount Report. The 2022 Report is attached below.

This information is useful not only for parish planning, but also for tracking growth and decline in the different geographical areas of the archdiocese. Additionally, it is a valuable tool for projecting the total population of the archdiocese, for providing the necessary information for required statistical reports, and for distribution of material for various initiatives.

Please note that the amount of a parish's assessment or the number of archdiocesan newspapers it receives are <u>not</u> derived from the October Headcount, but rather from data

collected through the annual Parish Statistical Report that is requested in the summer after the end of the fiscal year.


