## Mass or Special Event Meeting Requests for 2023-2024

If your parish/school/ministry/organization is celebrating a Mass or hosting a special event between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024, at which you would like to request the presence of Cardinal Gregory or one of the auxiliary bishops, you are asked to complete and return the Calendar Request Form, linked <u>here</u>, by Tuesday, May 2, 2023.

Be assured that every effort will be made to accommodate your request(s), however, as much as the Cardinal and the auxiliary bishops wish they could honor every invitation received, we regret that it is simply not possible. Your office will be notified as soon as the calendar for your particular date has been finalized.

Please note that if you have previously requested Cardinal Gregory to attend an event by way of letter, email or memorandum in the past few months, I ask that you now submit a calendar request.


