I write today to provide you with updates and will continue to share with you information as needed.

Changes in Pastoral Center Organizational Chart

His Eminence Wilton Cardinal Gregory has made the following changes to the Pastoral Center organizational chart and reporting structure:

The Office of the General Counsel will report to the Office of the Moderator of the Curia.

The Secretariat of Pastoral Ministry and Social Concerns will report to the Office of Auxiliary Bishop Evelio Menjivar. The Office of Cultural Diversity and Outreach will also report to Bishop Menjivar.

Auxiliary Bishop Roy Campbell will continue as Chair of the College of Deans. Cardinal Gregory has also asked that Bishop Campbell oversee the Graves of the Enslaved project at Sacred Heart Cemetery and the Jesuit Property in Bowie.

The Office of Child Protection and Safe Environment will report to the Office of the Chief Operating Officer.

The Office for Catechesis has been elevated to the Secretariat for Catechesis and will continue to report to the Office of the Moderator of the Curia. Cardinal Gregory has appointed Sara Blauvelt as the Secretary for Catechesis.

The Office of the Moderator of the Tribunal Chancery has been elevated to the Secretariat for Canonical Services and will continue to report to the Office of the Moderator of the Curia. Cardinal Gregory has appointed Dr. Sofia Markovich, Metropolitan Judge, as the Secretary for Canonical Services.

Both Dr. Markovich and Sara Blauvelt have been appointed to the Administrative Board.
