## **Collection and Deposit Procedure**

- If your parish has an online donation portal, parishioners can donate directly online. Please note "SPA 2024" if there is a memo option in the online portal. If they are writing a check, announce to parishioners that checks must be made payable to the parish with the memo line reading "SPA 2024."
- 2. On the remittance check, include your parish number and the collection name "Other collections." The ADW Code is 18-4931 and the Parish Code is 85-984.
- 3. Use the deposit slip: For the Account of Archdiocese of Washington. Write the total amount on the line "Other unbilled," which is found towards the bottom of the deposit slip.
- 4. Scan and email a copy of the check and the deposit slip to Maeve Gilheney-Gallagher at Gallagher MC@adw.org.
