Statement From the Archdiocese

Earlier this week, reporters from various news organizations posed questions regarding the Child Victims Act, which was recently enacted in the state of Maryland. In response to those questions the archdiocese issued the following statement:

The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Washington is asserting its legal defenses in the cases filed against it. We remain committed, however, to our longstanding efforts to bring healing to survivors through pastoral care and other forms of assistance that are available apart from the legal process. We are also committed to maintaining our robust safe environment policies that have been in place for decades to ensure the protection of all those who are entrusted to our care.
