



Instructions for Making a World Mission Rosary

Part 1

1. Cut string into an arm's length (24 inches)
2. Burn end of string to prevent fraying or dip in clear nail polish
3. Tie white cross to the end of the white string.
4. String 1 yellow bead (Our Father)
5. String 2 clear spacer beads
6. String 1 red bead, a white bead, then a green bead (Hail Mary, for the Virtues of Faith, Hope and Charity)
7. String 2 clear spacer beads
8. String 1 green bead (Our Father, First Decade for Africa)
9. **Take the end of the string and put it through the singular hole at the BOTTOM of the White Mary medal, then immediately string it through ONE of the top holes. Leave the other hole open as you will use this at the end. Tie a single knot to seal the Medal.**





Part 2

10. String 10 green beads (Hail Mary)
11. String 2 clear spacer beads
12. String 1 blue bead (Our Father, Second Decade for Oceania)
13. String 2 clear spacer beads
14. String 10 blue beads (Hail Mary)
15. String 2 clear spacer beads
16. String 1 white bead (Our Father, Third Decade for Europe)
17. String 2 clear spacer beads
18. String 10 white beads (Hail Mary)
19. String 2 clear spacer beads
20. String 1 large red bead (Our Father, Fourth Decade for the Americas)
21. String 2 clear spacer beads
22. String 10 red beads (Hail Mary)
23. String 2 clear spacer beads
24. String 1 yellow bead (Our Father, Fifth Decade for Asia)
25. String 2 clear spacer beads
26. String 10 yellow beads (Hail Mary)



Part 3.

27. Take the end of the string and feed it through the last open hole on the White Medal. Make a double knot as close to the medal as possible, to prevent the beads from moving.
